Dear Property Owner,

The property you recently purchased is served by an Aerobic Treatment Unit (ATU). This is a specialized septic system that requires regular maintenance and inspections. Attached is a packet that contains some general information, laws regulating ATUs, an operating permit application (DEP 4081), and a list of contractors that are certified to maintain ATUs along with the model of ATU they are certified to maintain.

Per Florida Administrative Code Rule 62-6.003(5)(b), "Operating permits are not transferable." Therefore, when a new owner takes possession of a property, the operating permit held by the previous property owner becomes invalid, and a new operating permit must be obtained by the new owner.

As the homeowner, you are required to obtain an operating permit from the Florida Department of Health in Charlotte County (DOH-Charlotte) by submitting the attached application, DEP 4081, and paying a \$200 fee. You are also required to contract with a qualified maintenance entity to maintain your ATU and submit a copy of the maintenance agreement to DOH-Charlotte.

You can submit the operating permit application (DEP 4081) and a copy of the maintenance agreement via email to [Charlotte.EH@FLhealth.gov](mailto:Charlotte.EH@FLhealth.gov). You can also submit it in person or by mail at 1100 Loveland Blvd. Port Charlotte, FL 33980. Both an operating permit and maintenance agreement are required for the life of the ATU. Please note that there is a \$50 late fee if the payment is not received by the due date.

Finally, while you are not required to answer the questions below, your responses will assist us with understanding how your ATU will be used and facilitate future communications. You can provide us with your responses by either returning this letter with your operating permit application or otherwise noting this information at the time of application submission.

# AEROBIC TREATMENT UNITS (ATU)

## WHAT IS AN ATU?

It is an advanced septic system that treats the sewage waste to a higher degree than a conventional system. The water leaving the tank and going into the groundwater is cleaner and therefore helps prevent the pollution of our ground water, canals and rivers.

## WHY MUST I HAVE A MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT AND OPERATING PERMIT?

Since the systems must be maintained to function properly, Florida State law requires that if they are used, an operating permit from the Florida Department of Health in Charlotte County (DOH-Charlotte) and a maintenance agreement with an approved Maintenance Entity (ME) must be in effect for the life of the system. The operating permit will not be issued unless there is a current maintenance agreement. This is to ensure that both the contract and permit are renewed and in effect. The operating permit is renewed every two years. The maintenance entity or property owner may choose to renew the maintenance agreement for one or two years following the initial two years.

## WHO IS APPROVED TO MAINTAIN THE SYSTEM?

ATUs are made by different manufacturers. Each manufacturer approves companies to install and service their brand. Each builder hires or contracts with a company that installs septic systems. The brand you have may only have one ME or several. DOH-Charlotte has control over the number of MEs a manufacturer certifies to install or maintain the systems. A state licensed plumber or registered septic contractor must register to work in Charlotte County while providing an application and course certifications before maintaining any ATU.

## WHAT DOES THE OPERATING PERMIT COST COVER ?

DOH-Charlotte is the agency in charge of the septic program and has the responsibility to ensure that ATU's are maintained and functioning properly. The DOH-Charlotte operating permit fee covers:

1. One inspection of the system per year and additional inspections if necessary for any problems. The inspector conducts a visual inspection of the system, listens to ensure that the system is running, checks the aerator and tests the alarm, looks for obvious problems such as excessive noise, pests, any air leaks, and check the sample port. Then we update the data bases used to track the ATU systems.
2. The ME is to conduct two inspections each year, approximately every six months. DOH-Charlotte tracks that all inspections by the ME are done and recorded.
3. Track that the maintenance agreement and operating permit are renewed. Reminders are sent out prior to expiration of the permit and maintenance agreement. Once the operating permit and maintenance agreement are overdue legal notices are sent, and potential enforcement action.

## WHY DO I HAVE THIS SYSTEM?

You may live in the "BMAP"(Basin Management Action Plan) where the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has deemed environmentally sensitive area, lot size restrictions, builders choice, or an old county ordinance.

## WHY WAS I NOT TOLD ABOUT THIS SYSTEM WHEN I BOUGHT OR BUILT THIS HOME?

We receive complaints from property owners stating that their builder or real-estate agent never informed them about this system. Real estate agents may not be familiar with ATUs or their requirements and rely on the property owner for this information. The current property owner should disclose that the property is serviced by an ATU and advise them of the requirements prior to the purchase, including letting DOH-Charlotte know of the purchase and update our records. The DOH-Charlotte recommends that if you are purchasing a home, you have the system evaluated by a licensed company to disclose failures or problems and would identify if it is an ATU.

## WHAT IS MY RESPONSIBILITY?

Your responsibility as an owner of an ATU is to maintain a current maintenance contract and operating permit, and have it repaired or pumped when needed. Also, you should keep the aerator on at all times and check periodically to ensure that the unit is running. If there is a problem with the operation of the unit, call your Maintenance Entity (they are required to respond within 36 hours). When you are selling the home, disclose that the property is serviced by an ATU and the requirements to have an operating permit and maintenance contract.

Dear Homeowner:

The 2013 Florida Legislature made several changes to subsection 381.0065(4), Florida Statutes, in regard to sewage treatment performance-based treatment systems (PBTS) and aerobic treatment unit (ATU) requirements. This legislation becomes law on July 1, 2013. **According to our records you have one of these onsite sewage systems on your property.** Below is a summary for your information and action.

1. House Bill 375 reiterated existing law that exempts property owners from obtaining a septic tank contractor's registration, while permitting them to work on the onsite sewage treatment and disposal system serving their owner-occupied, single-family home. If you decide to maintain your own system and not use a septic-service contractor known as a Maintenance Entity (ME), you must obtain a Maintenance Entity Service permit from the department. You will be required to receive maintenance training from the ATU manufacturer or PBTS designer and obtain training certification in writing, pay the annual service permit fee (\$25), and report all service performed on the system to the County Health Department in your county. Requests for training should be made to your system manufacturer or their local representative. Please note: the law does not allow the department to mandate that a manufacturer provide training to anyone requesting it, and the manufacturer may decline your request. Once you have received training you may make application to the local County Health Department to be "permitted" as the ME for your system. The application for maintenance service permit (DEP 4066) form is available online at [Charlotte.FloridaHealth.gov/dep-4066](http://Charlotte.FloridaHealth.gov/dep-4066).

2. New language requires you, as the property owner, to obtain the biennial Operating Permit for your home's system. This provision applies whether you serve as your own ME or use a contracted ME. If you have already paid your ME for the permit renewal, you can request the ME to pay for the permit this time, or request a refund from the ME in writing. If the ME refuses to pay for the permit or make a refund, please provide the local County Health Department with a copy of your refund request and documentation of your payment to the ME. The Department can take disciplinary action against the contractor's license, but this does not relieve you of your obligation to make payment and obtain the onsite sewage system's operating permit. You and your ME may still opt to have the ME obtain the operating permit on your behalf, according to your agreement.

3. Finally, the new law allows the use of equivalent spare parts for ATUs only, after the original warranty period. The ME is required to maintain documentation of the substitute parts equivalency for two years. Documentation is a letter from the spare part manufacturer or a licensed professional engineer stating the part is equivalent to the original part and providing specifications. The use of spare parts must be reported to the department, upon request, with the required documentation by the ME or, if the owner is the ME, by the owner.
